EXHIBITION DATES

The exhibit will be on display at the E.E. Bass Cultural Arts Center from Thursday, February 23rd to Monday, March 20th, 2017. The exhibit can be visited during public building hours Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. After the exhibit closes, all work needs to be picked up from Bass on Tuesday, March 21st or Wednesday, March 22nd, during building hours. NOTE: The Greenville Arts Council realizes that other exhibits and entry deadlines may conflict with the Annual Student Invitational. We will gladly work with teachers to coordinate pick-up before March 20th if work needs to be submitted to another competition.

OPENING RECEPTION AND PRIZES

The Greenville Arts Council will host an opening reception on Thursday, February 23rd, 2017 from 4–6 p.m. The opening reception is free and open to the public. Light refreshments will be provided. The winning artists in each of the award categories below will receive a ribbon and prize. Prizes can be picked up during the opening reception or during regular building hours (10 a.m.–4 p.m M-F) following the reception.

ELIGIBILITY

The student invitational is open to all Washington County students in grades Pre-Kindergarten through 12.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

Artwork of all mediums, including but not limited to paintings, original prints, drawings, graphics, photographs, ceramics and 3-D sculptures may be entered. Artwork does <u>not</u> have to be framed or matted to be considered for judging; however, if artwork is entered without being mounted on construction paper or a mat, the Greenville Arts Council may add one for display purposes; if your student artist would prefer not to have their work mounted, please specify on the entry form. All efforts will be made to return the artwork in the condition is it submitted, but please be aware that small tears may result from the hanging process.

ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

Entries will be judged in person by the juror. All entries must be submitted with the attached form by Friday, February 17th at 4 p.m. Student artists may only submit one piece of artwork unless the students are participating in a group project, in which case they may submit an individual piece to be considered as well.
